Findings

Distraction Index (DI): Right DI = 0.61, the left DI was not computed.
Osteoarthritis (OA): No radiographic evidence of OA for either hip.
Cavitation/Other Findings: Cavitation was present on the left hip. Cavitation is harmless to the hip, however it can artificially and temporarily increase the distraction index. Therefore, no laxity score is provided for the left hip.

Interpretation

Distraction Index (DI): One hip cannot be used for the laxity ranking (see Findings). The opposite hip will be used in the analysis. The value of the DI is 0.61. OA Risk Category: The DI is between 0.50 and 0.69. This patient is at moderate risk for hip OA. Distraction Index Chart: COTON DE TULEAR Low Risk Mild Risk Moderate Risk High Risk DI = 0.61 Distraction Index
BREED STATISTICS: This interpretation is based on a cross-section of 145 canine patients of the COTON DE TULEAR breed in the AIS PennHIP database. The gray strip represents the central 90% range of DIs (0.38 - 0.90) for the breed. The breed average DI is 0.63 (solid square). The patient DI is the solid circle (0.61).
SUMMARY: The degree of laxity (DI = 0.61) falls within the central 90% range of DIs for the breed. This amount of hip laxity places the hip at a moderate risk to develop hip OA. No radiographic evidence of OA for either hip.
